**Oxford City Schools: Less Paperwork,  
More Impact**

**Simplifying IEP Compliance Without  
Adding More to Teachers' Plates**

## The Challenge

Marilyn Burke is the Special Education Coordinator for Oxford City Schools, a mid-sized district in Alabama serving a diverse population of students. She oversees the identification, services, and supports for students with disabilities and gifted students. One of her biggest challenges? Balancing meaningful support with the growing demands of documentation.

"Addressing each student's needs individually and documenting those services and supports can be an overwhelming task for teachers who are also providing those services," Burke explained.

The district had been relying on a mix of paper documentation, spreadsheets, and Google Forms—an approach that was not only inefficient but added significant administrative burden to special education staff.

## Why Brolly?

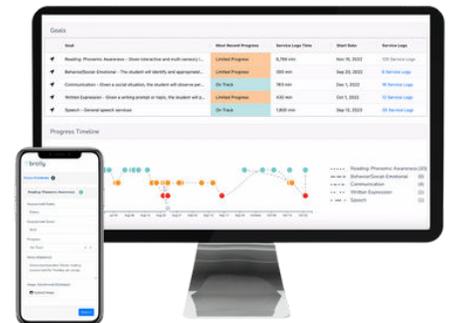
Burke began searching for a tool that could streamline documentation without adding more tasks to her team.

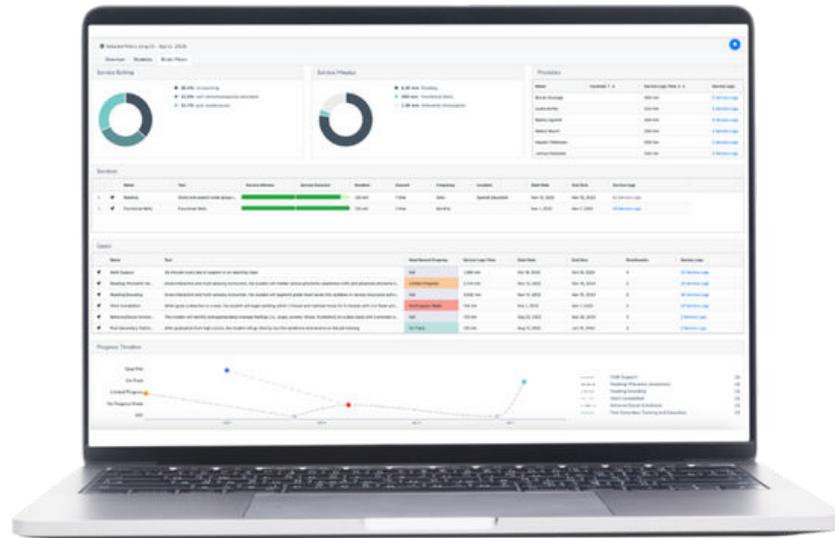
"The way services were documented when we first began was different and took some time for staff to get used to," shared Marilyn Burke.
